



CALL FOR REFERRALS

The Waterloo Region Street Gang Prevention Project, inREACH provides support to youth ages 13-24 in Waterloo Region who are actively involved, associated with or might be thinking about joining a gang.

inREACH is now accepting referrals for youth to attend the next program session. Referrals can be made by youth themselves, parents, agencies, schools or police at any time. The program will be offered multiple times per year reaching up to 60 youth per year.

Participants will receive one-on-one support, connections to housing supports, employment counselling, mental health and addictions support and access to recreation activities. To learn more about inREACH visit www.leadyourlife.ca.
